



## ThingLink Instructions

### What is ThingLink?

At its most basic level, teachers and students can start with an image, define it through multimedia and pack it full of content to present knowledge and ideas. It's a great tool for teachers at any level of tech integration because of its simple, flexible design.

### How do I get started?

- Sign up for a free education account at <https://www.thinglink.com/edu> (teacher)
- Or log in using Twitter, Facebook, or Google+

### How do I create a new project?

1. Log in to your ThingLink account
2. Press "Create" at the top right (red button)
3. Upload from your computer or import an image from the internet
  - \*Note: Importing from Facebook requires you to login to Facebook, Flickr and Google importing searches images with a creative commons license.

### How do I add content to my project?

- Give your project a title (top)
- Click on the image to add a Tag. A tag can be a:
  - Text
  - Link to an image, video, or audio
- Change the tag image
- Search for online content to add to your image on the top left
- Adjust your sharing settings (bottom left)
  - Public
  - Unlisted
  - Allow anyone to edit



### What do I do when I'm finished with my project?

- Press save (bottom right)

### How do I go back and edit my project?

1. Find your project under the "Me" tab (top right)
2. Select the project you want to edit
3. Press the edit button (pencil icon)

### How do I share my project?

1. Find your project
2. Select the share button (box-arrow icon)
3. You have choices to share using a URL link, on social media, or embed code for a website/blog
